DISCOUNTING OF ATTORNEY FEES.

It is improper for an attorney to discount the fees which he charges for a simple will, contingent on his client's contributing money to a charitable organization which advertises the attorney's services. [See II: DR:2-103(D), DR:3-102, DR:5-101(A) and DR:5-104(A).]
