LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 404

PRESERVATION OF CONFIDENCES
AND SECRETS.

An attorney advised by his client during the course of the attorney/client relationship that the client had secreted certain weapons which were the object of a search warrant may not reveal his client's actions to law enforcement officials. Such information is a confidence protected by the attorney/client privilege. [See EC:4-1 and DR:4-101(B); and DR:4-101(D) is not applicable.]
