LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 450

OFFICE SHARING – CLAIMS
ADJUSTER.

It is not improper for an attorney who is an owner of an office building to rent office space to an insurance claims adjuster. It is also not improper for the attorney, as landlord, to provide secretarial services to the adjusting business, even though the attorney maintains a separate law office in the same building, as long as the attorney complies with DR:4-101(B) & (E) and DR:5-101(A).

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
