LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 451

ASSISTANT COMMONWEALTH'S  
ATTORNEY.

It is ethically permissible and not contrary to DR:9-101(B) for a part-time Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney to represent a licensed podiatrist, who alleges that he has been impermissibly denied hospital clinical privileges under § 32.1-134.2 of the Code of Virginia, in a jurisdiction other than where the lawyer acts as Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney.
