LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 493

CONFLICT OF INTEREST –
INSURANCE ATTORNEY
REPRESENTING PLAINTIFF.

It is not improper for an attorney, who usually represents the tortfeasor's insurance company, to represent the plaintiff in a personal injury claim against the tortfeasor, if the prior consent of both parties is obtained. [DR:5-105(A), (C), (D), EC:5-19]
