LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 494

DECEPTIVE COMMUNICATIONS.

It is improper for a plaintiff's attorney to advise a potential tort defendant in a disputed liability claim that he will be responsible for costs other than those taxable by the court, or to state that the defendant's credit will be greatly impaired unless the amount claimed is paid in full.
