LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 502

RETIRED JUDGE – VICARIOUS
DISQUALIFICATION OF COUNSEL.

Attorneys who associate with a retired judge are not precluded from practicing in the courts of his Commonwealth under any provision of the Virginia Code of Professional Responsibility, even though the retired judge is disqualified from appearing as counsel in any case in any court of the Commonwealth by § 51-179, Va. Code. [DR:5-105]
