LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 521

CONFLICT OF INTEREST/
COMMUNICATION WITH ADVERSE
PARTY.

The provisions of DR:7-104(A) would bar direct contact between an attorney and an adverse party who is represented by counsel. Neither the fact that the attorney is representing himself nor the claim that the adverse party's attorney is wrongfully withholding information from the adverse party would constitute an exception to the rule.
