LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 630

CONFIDENTIALITY – COMPLAINT
AGAINST HEARING OFFICER BY
ATTORNEY.

It is not improper for an attorney to submit a motion for the disqualification of a hearing officer based upon the fact that said attorney had previously filed an ethics complaint against the hearing officer in an unrelated matter; the committee makes no comment with respect to the legal considerations of making such a motion.
