LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 636

CONFLICT OF INTEREST –
COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY
PROSECUTING PARTY ADVERSE TO
SPOUSE'S CLIENT.

It is improper for a commonwealth's attorney to prosecute a traffic charge against an individual who is currently or prospectively the defendant in a personal injury claim in which the plaintiff is represented by the attorney/wife of the commonwealth's attorney.
