ATTORNEY'S FEES – CONTINGENT
FEES IN INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION
CASES.

It is not improper for an attorney to charge a contingent fee in a workman's compensation matter assuming that the total fee is approved by the Industrial Commission. [DR:2-105(C), § 65.1-102, Virginia Code, 1950 (as amended), In The Matter of Abraham M. Fisch, 188 N.Y. App. Div. 525, 531 (1931)]
