CONFIDENCE AND SECRETS – CLIENT  
IDENTITY DISCLOSURE – CITY  
COUNCIL.

It is not improper for attorney members of a local governing body to disclose the identity of clients to whom the attorney has provided legal services of a stated monetary value, when such disclosure is required by an ordinance of the locality.
