LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 768

EVIDENCE – MISREPRESENTING  
EVIDENCE OF EXPERT WITNESSES.

It is improper for an attorney to prepare answers to interrogatories which misrepresent the identity of an expert witness and the substance of the evidence to be offered by the expert witness in a medical malpractice claim.
