LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 781

INSURANCE – MULTIPLE CLIENTS.

It is not unethical for an insurer's counsel to tender offers to coplaintiffs with the condition that if either rejects, then both offers will be discontinued or withdrawn. The committee is of the view, however, that the above described situation emphasizes the duty of the attorney for the coplaintiffs to abide by DR:5-107. [DR:5-107]
