LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 811

CONFLICT OF INTEREST – CREDITOR  
OF ESTATE AND COUNSEL TO  
ADMINISTRATOR.

It is not improper for an attorney to represent the administrator of an estate even though the attorney's firm is a creditor of the estate, if the attorney obtains the consent of the administrator client after full disclosure. [ DR:5-101(A), § 64.1-171 and § 64.1-174 of the Virginia Code]
