LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 874

ATTORNEYS – SHARED OFFICE
SPACE.

An attorney shares office space with a law firm located in a large building. Access to the attorney's office may only be gained by going through an area entirely utilized by the sharing firm. Under the circumstances, it would be appropriate for the attorney to emplace a sign in the elevator lobby or the lobby of the sharing firm to clearly identify the attorney's status as a solo practitioner having no connection with the sharing firm.
