CORPORATIONS – CONFLICT OF  
INTEREST.

It is not improper for an attorney to assist in a recovery on behalf of a corporate entity when the corporate entity is adverse to the attorney's client in litigation and has assigned its rights against the individual from whom recovery may be made to client's attorney.
