LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 928

ATTORNEY/CLIENT PRIVILEGE –
POST-DEATH OF CLIENT.

It is not proper, post-death, for an attorney's files to be turned over to an institution. The committee opines that post-death, the wishes of the client are still a dominant consideration. [DR:4-101; EC:4-6; LE Op. 812]
