LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 951

ATTORNEY – FAMILIAL  
RELATIONSHIP – CONFLICT OF  
INTEREST.

It is not improper for an attorney in firm "A" to represent a client when the adverse party is represented by the spouse of another attorney in firm "A" as long as the attorney makes full and adequate disclosure to and receives consent from his client. Conversely, it is not improper for the spouse to continue representing her client as long as full disclosure is made to her client and consent received. [ LE Op. 619 and LE Op. 190]
