LEGAL ETHICS OPINION 963

ATTORNEY/CLIENT –  
COMMUNICATING WITH ADVERSE  
PARTY.

It is improper for an attorney to send a letter to the opposing party concerning judgment matters during the appeal period from the general district court when the opposing party was represented by counsel at trial even though no appeal had yet been filed nor had opposing party's attorney indicated an appeal would be filed.
