ORDER

On December 20, 2013, pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-23.A of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court, the Disciplinary Board entered an Order suspending Joseph Graham Painter, Jr.'s license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia. The Order was based upon an Order entered by the Circuit Court of the County of Montgomery on December 9, 2013, that Joseph Graham Painter, Jr., had been adjudicated by a court of competent jurisdiction to have an impairment.

Based upon the Disciplinary Board's receipt of documentary evidence of adjudication by the Circuit Court of Montgomery County, Order Removing Conditions of Conditional Release, entered April 21, 2017, that Joseph Graham Painter, Jr.'s impairment has terminated, and pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-23.I, of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court, it is **ORDERED**, that the suspension of Mr. Painter's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia imposed by the Disciplinary Board on December 20, 2013, is hereby terminated effective May 11, 2017.
