AFFIDAVIT DECLARING CONSENT TO REVOCATION

I, Christopher DeCoy Parrott, after being duly sworn, state as follows:

1. I was licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on October 13, 2005.

2. I submit this Affidavit Declaring Consent to Revocation pursuant to Rule of Court, Part 6, Section IV, Paragraph 13-28.

3. My consent to revocation is freely and voluntarily rendered. I am not being subjected to coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the implications of consenting to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

4. I am aware that there is currently pending a complaint, an investigation into, or a proceeding involving, allegations of misconduct, the docket number for which is set forth above, and the specific nature of which is set forth below:

- a. On November 21, 2016, my license to practice law in Virginia was suspended for 21 months, effective immediately.
- b. On May 19, 2017, my license to practice law in Virginia was suspended for an additional six months. The additional suspension resulted from my failure to comply with the Rules of Court, Part 6, § IV, ¶ 13-29 (“¶ 13-29”).
- c. At the May 19, 2017 hearing, I submitted an affidavit stating that as of November 21, 2016, “I do not have any clients for whom I am currently handling matters.”
- d. My affidavit was not true. In fact, I had several clients for whom I was handling matters as of November 21, 2016. My submission of the false

affidavit violated Rules of Professional Conduct 3.3(a)(1) and 8.4(b) and (c).

- e. I also failed to notify my clients of my suspension as required by ¶ 13-29.
- f. I continued to perform legal work on behalf of my clients after my license to practice law was suspended in violation of Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5(c).

5. I acknowledge that the material facts upon which the allegations of misconduct are predicated are true.

6. I submit this affidavit and consent to the revocation of my license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia because I know that if the disciplinary proceedings based on the said alleged misconduct were brought or prosecuted to a conclusion, I could not successfully defend them.
