INTERIM SUSPENSION ORDER

Pursuant to Part Six, Section IV, Paragraph 13-6 G.3. of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, it is ORDERED that Kathryn Suzanne Pennington's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia be and hereby is suspended effective November 26, 2018. The suspension shall remain in effect until the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board determines that Kathryn Suzanne Pennington has fully complied with the subpoena *duces tecum* served on October 1, 2018.

It is further ORDERED that Kathryn Suzanne Pennington must comply with the requirements of Part Six, § IV, ¶ 13-29 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia. The Respondent shall forthwith give notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the suspension or revocation of her license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia, to all clients for whom she is currently handling matters and to all opposing attorneys and presiding judges in pending litigation. The Respondent shall also make appropriate arrangements for the disposition of matters then in her care in conformity with the wishes of her client. Respondent shall give such notice within 14 days of the effective date of the sanction, and make such arrangements as are required herein within 45 days of the effective date of the suspension. The Respondent shall also furnish proof to the Bar within 60 days of the effective day of the suspension that such notices have been timely given and such arrangements made for the disposition of matters.

It is further ORDERED that if the Respondent is not handling any client matters on the effective date of the suspension, she shall submit an affidavit to that effect to the Clerk of the Disciplinary System at the Virginia State Bar. All issues concerning the adequacy of the notice and arrangements required by Paragraph 13-29 shall be determined by the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary

Board.

It is further ORDERED that all notices specified in Paragraph 13-29 must be given even if the Respondent is reinstated within 14 days of the Suspension.
