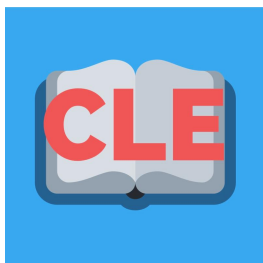
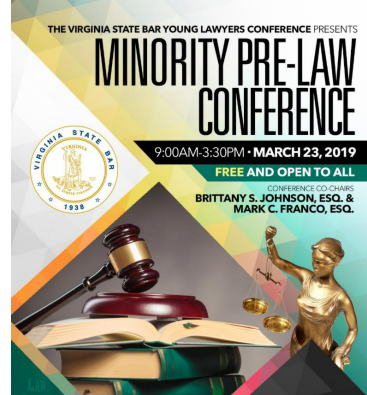

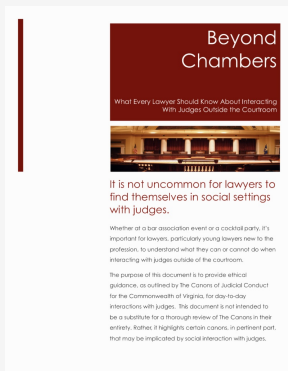


## March 28: Understanding the Immigration Consequences of Criminal Dispositions in Virginia
